We are looking for volunteers to assist with this event. If you can help please contact the office.

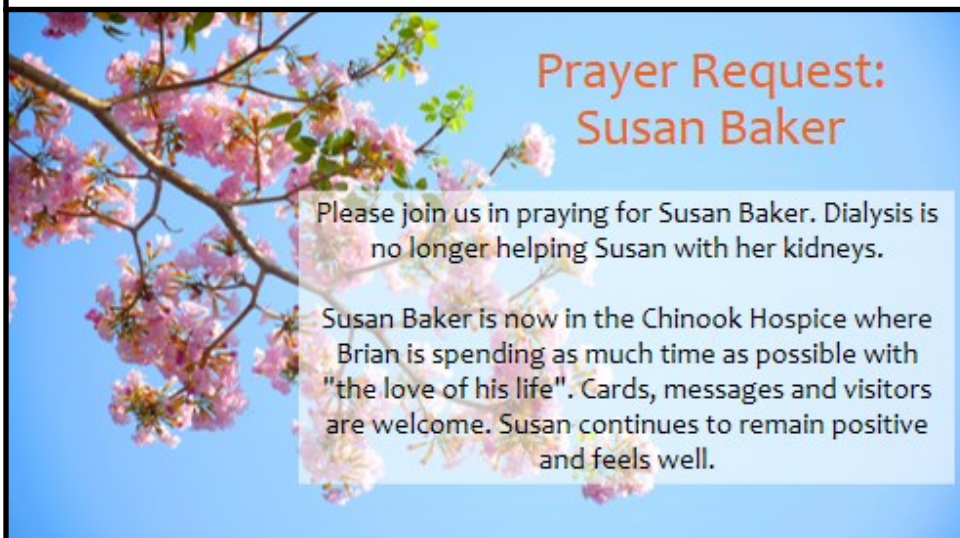
